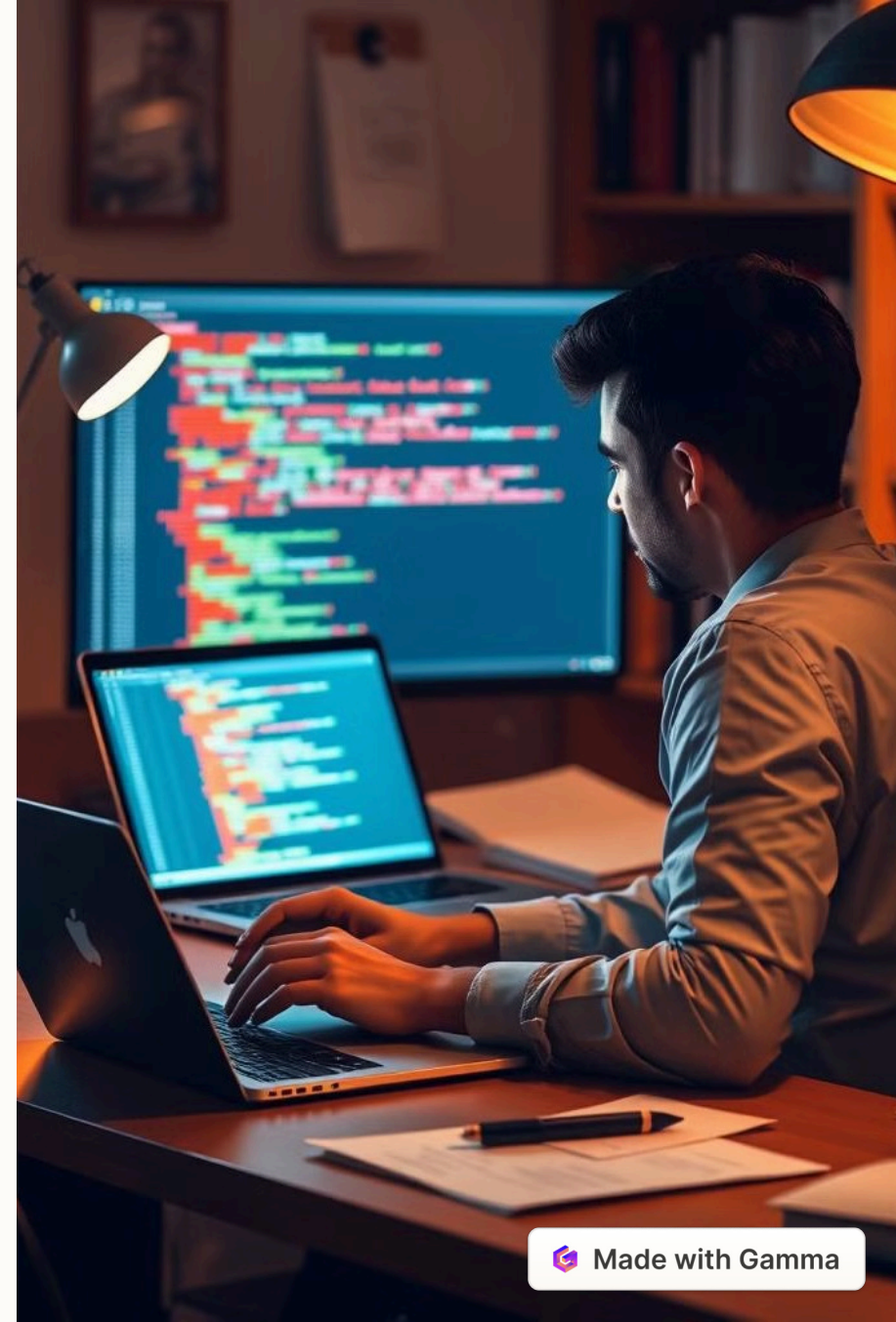

Containerization:

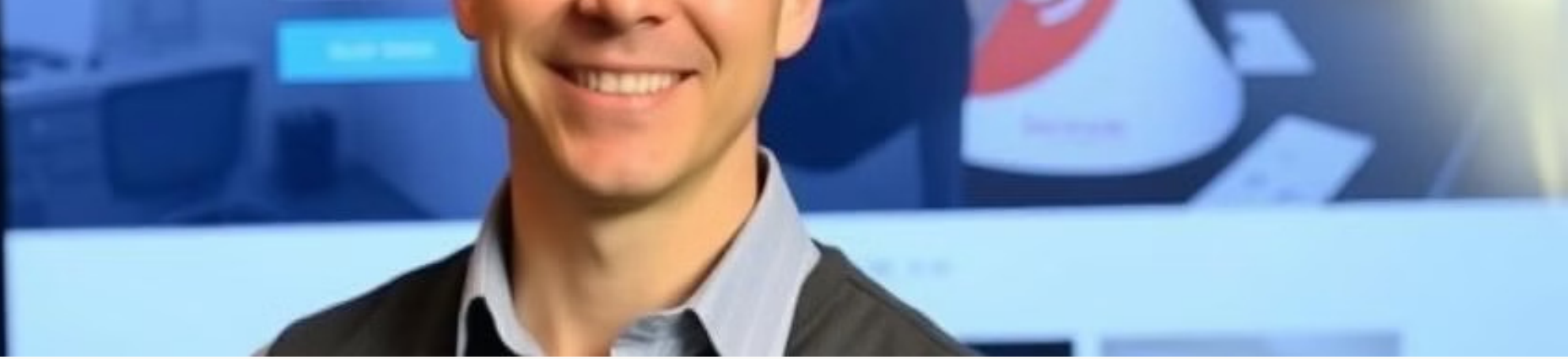
Gaining knowledge about Docker, Kubernetes, and their use cases in hosting.

Networking and Participating in Industry Events

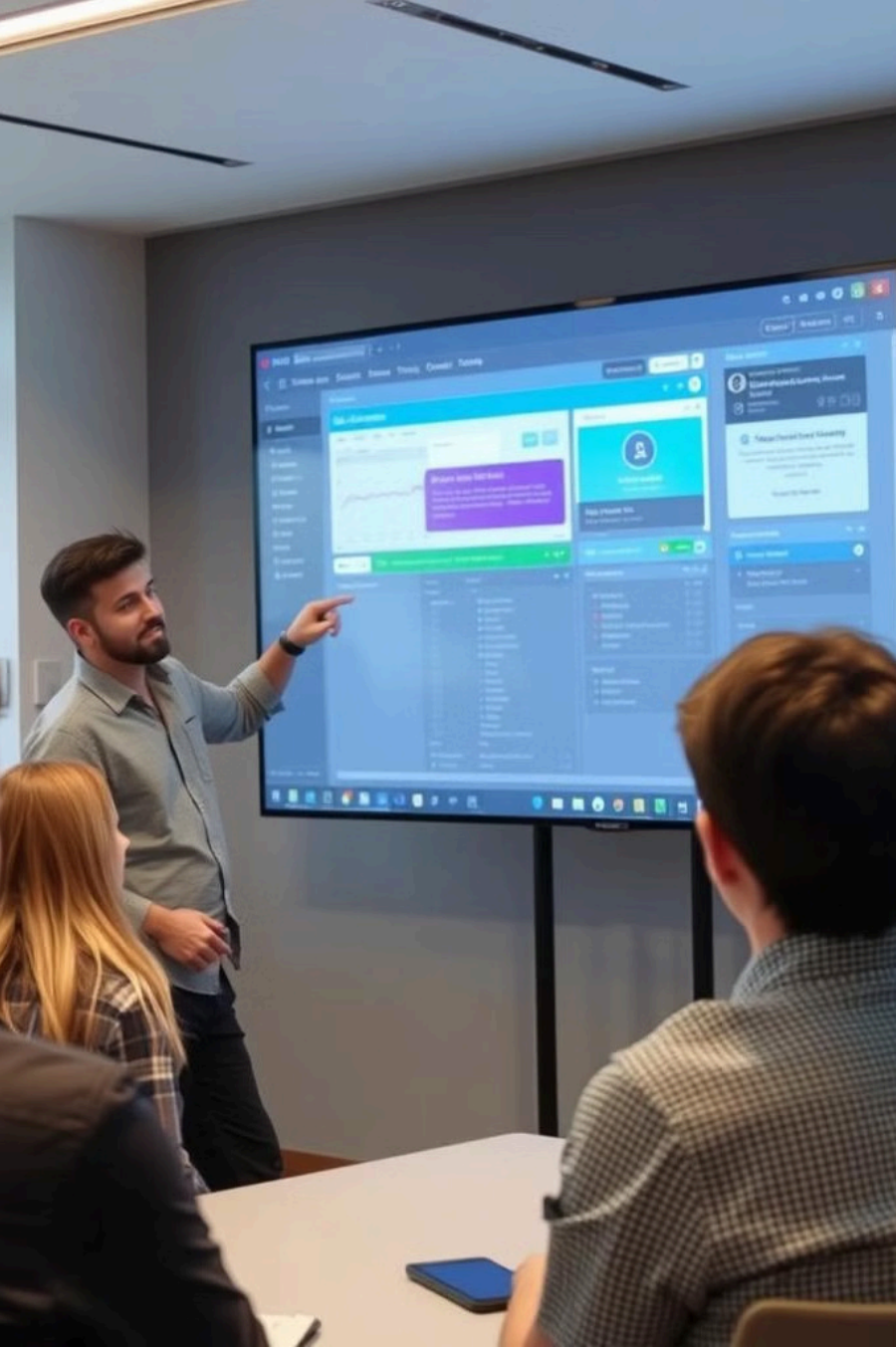
Networking Benefits

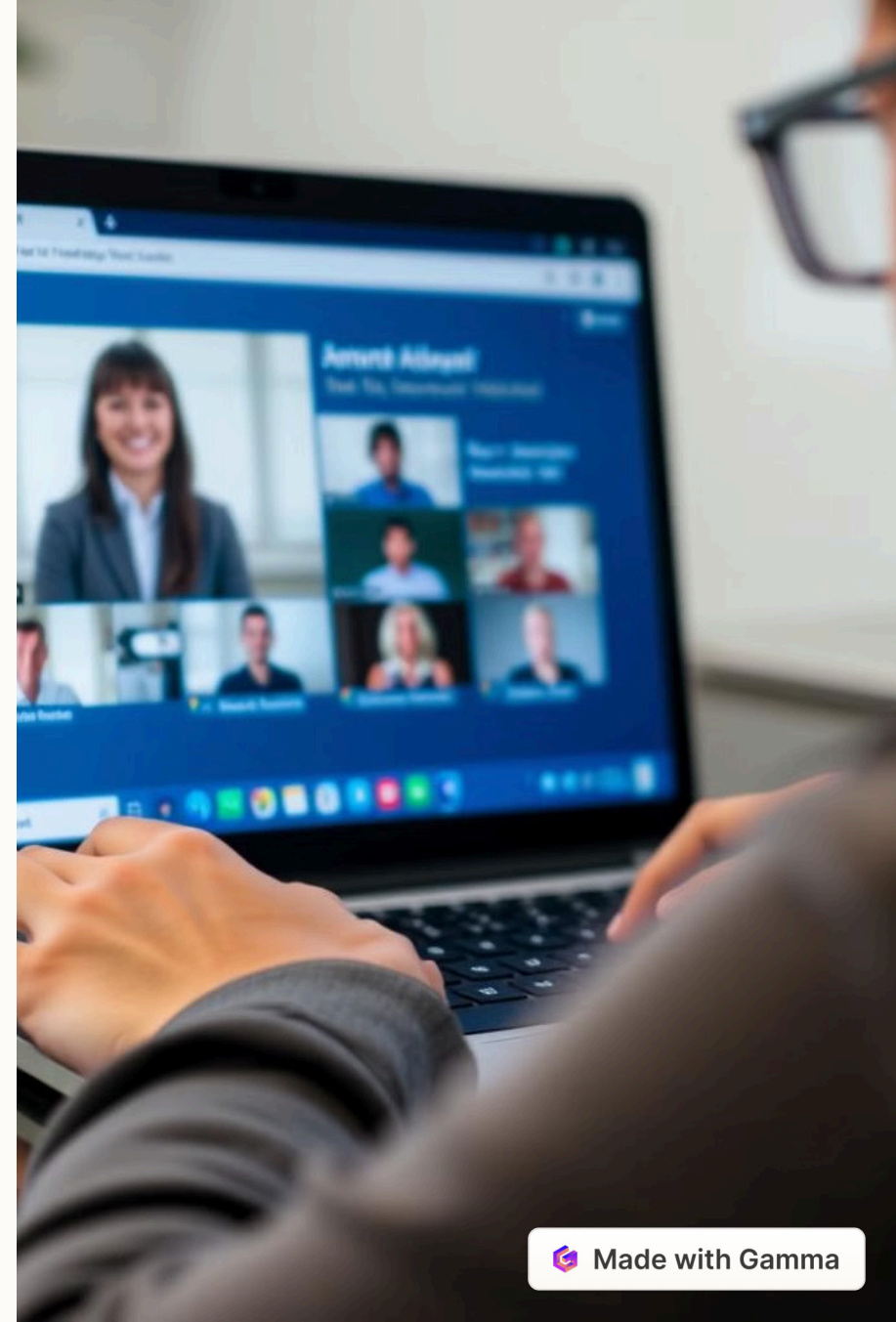
Situation
